What is the YMCA Youth Exchanges Canada (YEC) program?

It's a national exchange opportunity for youth aged 12–17 funded by the Government of Canada. The program pairs school and community groups from different regions in Canada for a reciprocal exchange. Participants travel to a different part of the country, immerse themselves in a new community, and host their twin group in their community. Youth develop essential skills, cultural awareness, and leadership.

Why Get Your Group Involved?

- Elevate your youth programs: Provide students with hands-on learning experiences beyond the classroom.
- Strengthen cultural awareness: Help youth discover Canada's diversity through real-life experiences.
- **Enhance leadership & teamwork:** Support youth in developing new skills, confidence, independence, and collaboration.



Group Eligibility

- Groups must be part of a recognized school or organization, with 10-30 participants.
- Members must be 12 to 17 years old and be first-time participants in YEC
- Leaders must be a minimum of 19 years old and apply on behalf of their group.



Program Costs & Funding

- There is a participation fee for each group member.
- Travel for all eligible participants and organizers is funded by the Government of
- Local hosting, transportation, and activities costs are the group's responsibility.
