The book was to be a revolutionary, personal account of the lives and assassinations of three of his close friends: Medgar Evers, Malcolm X and Martin Luther King, Jr. This film envisions the book that Baldwin left unfinished at the time of his death in 1987.

Hidden Figures is a 2016 American biographical drama film loosely based on the 2016 non-fiction book of the same name by Margot Lee Shetterly about three female African American mathematicians: Katherine Goble Johnson, Dorothy Vaughan, and Mary Jackson, who worked at NASA during the Space Race.
